Our starting interest this half term is Amelia Earhart beginning our topic on Travel and Space. This half term Reception will be learning to . . .

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

- Make comments about what they have heard and ask questions to clarify their understanding.
- Answer how and why questions
- Offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, nonfiction, rhymes and poems when appropriate.

Vocabulary: how? Why? When? What if? because.

PERSONAL SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Try new activities and say why they like some more than others
- Set and work towards simple goals, being able to wait for what they want and control their immediate impulses when appropriate.
- Be confident to try new activities and show independence, resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge.

Vocabulary: fasten, zip, side, up, down, back , forward, listen, challenge, calm, understand.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Negotiate space and obstacles safely, with consideration for themselves and others.
- Demonstrate strength, balance and coordination when playing.
- Move energetically, such as running, jumping, dancing, hopping, skipping and climbing.
- Hold a pencil effectively in preparation for fluent writing - using the tripod grip in almost all cases.
- Use a range of small tools, including scissors, paintbrushes and cutlery.
