

<p>COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Join in with repeated refrains Talk about what is happening now Introduce talk partners Respond to simple instructions Introduce Tasting and Smelling lens 	<p>PERSONAL SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Put on their coat, waterproof trousers and wellies Introduce snack Tuesday Introduce Casey the Crocodile who loves to concentrate 	<p>PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move in different ways e.g. skipping, galloping etc Swiggle whilst you wriggle -early writing skills Stir and spread a range of foods
<p>LITERACY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify different instrumental sounds Count and recognise syllables Begin to explore rhyme Talk about their pictures and writing Explore print in the environment Core books- Room on a Broom We're going on a Bear Hunt The three little pigs Make their name with magnetic letters Helicopter stories 	 <p>Other themes maybe developed as we follow the children's interests</p>	<p>MATHEMATICS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Count numbers in order Begin to recognise small sets without counting them e.g. subitising Recognise and copy a pattern <p>Maths Vocabulary copy, continue, create pattern colour, counting, number, set</p>
<p>UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about Birthdays, days of the week and months Talk about Special times Start a timeline of the year Name their school and know it is in Bedlington Talk about the different seasons and changes they notice Operate cd and computers 	<p>EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create different patterns Cut straight lines with scissors Use simple folding in their models Draw a person with a head and 1 or 2 features Print with different objects 	<p>CORE VALUE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Compassion 'It is good to be kind' RE Talk about family traditions e.g. Christmas, Birthdays Learn the Christmas story Introduce the prayer at the beginning of the sessions
