# PERSONAL SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Try new activities and say why they like some more than others
- Set and work towards simple goals, being able to wait for what they want and control their immediate impulses when appropriate.

### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Negotiate space and obstacles safely, with consideration for themselves and others.

- Hold a pencil effectively in preparation for fluent writing – using the tripod grip in almost all cases.
- Use a range of small tools, including scissors, paintbrushes and cutlery.
