English:

We will be using Nothing to See Here Hotel by Steven Butler to inspire our writing. We will be writing diary entries from characters in the hotel, and creating travel brochures too. We will also be using King Kong by Anthony Brown to create newspaper articles.

Time Allocation: 1/2 term

Reading:

In 'Whitley Reading' sessions we will be developing our inference skills, using texts including 'Nothing to see here hotel' and 'King Kong'.

Maths:

In multiplication and division, we will be working on our x-table knowledge in a variety of contexts. We will also be working on written methods of multiplication and division that predominantly use partitioning. We will also learn how to measure in mm, cm and metres.

Science: Animals including humans

We will be investigating different food groups and types of nutrition. We will be finding out about different types of skeletons and naming bones. We will learn about the main functions of the skeleton and how muscles work. We will be working scientifically to set up a simple experiment, make modifications, record results and write an explanation of our findings.

RF.

In RE we will be exploring the question: "What is it like to follow God?" We will explore the story of Noah and make links between the story and the idea of a covenant. We will make links between promises in the story of Noah and promises that Christians make at a wedding ceremony.
