English:

This term we will be exploring a range of Greek Myths before the children write their own version of their chosen myth—narrative.

We will then explore a non-chronological text on Ancient Greece.

Maths: Fractions and Decimals.

This half term we will continue our work on multiplication and division. Afterwards we will move onto finding the area and perimeter of a range of shapes, considering scale factors and applying our multiplication skills within this. Furthermore, we are focusing on our arithmetic skills and will do a weekly arithmetic paper to support this.

Science: Light

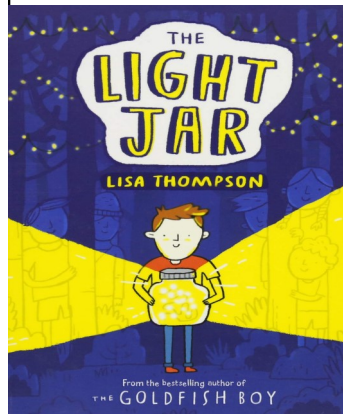
This half term we will explore the relationship between light sources, objects and shadows by using shadows puppets. We will also make our own periscope using the notion that light travels in a straight line.

Computing: Variables in games.
