Time Allocation: 1/2 term

Date: Summer Term 1

English/Communication:

We will continue with our reading and learn how to read fluently and for understanding. We will use our core book, Harry Potter, to write character and setting descriptions, a letter, instructions and a journey recount. We will continue to develop our understanding of nouns, adjectives, verbs, noun phrases, time adverbials, similes, alliteration, personification, repetition for impact and synonyms. We will be writing using full stops, capital letters, question marks, commas and exclamation marks. We will continue to use "inverted commas" to demarcate speech. During our SPAG lessons, we will investigate and learn how to use adverbs and prepositions to show how, time and place.

Maths:

In maths we will be continuing our work on measurement, and working on fractions by finding and recognising unit fractions. We will learn to represent, find and recognise non-unit fractions as well as use our knowledge to solve fraction related problems. We will also need to be practising and consolidating our times tables. We will learn how to recognise and find right angles.

Science: Light

We will recognise that we need light to see things and that dark is the absence of light. We will notice that light is reflected from surfaces. We will recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect our eyes. We will recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object. We will look for patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.


RE:
