English:

As readers we will be reading a variety of stories with familiar settings. As communicators we will develop our re-telling skills by ordering stories and re-telling them as a class, to each other and in writing. As writers, we will be writing signs, lists and labels, independently and in groups. We will begin to write simple sentences with finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Mathematics:

As mathematicians we will follow the national curriculum for mathematics. We will be reading, writing and ordering numbers to 10 using numbers and words. We will identify the number 1 more and 1 less. We will also be learning number bonds to 10 and addition and subtraction facts within 10.

Science: Everyday Materials:

As scientists we will be finding out what everyday objects are made out of. We will identify and name a variety of materials including wood, plastic, glass, metal, fabric, water and rock. We will describe the simple physical properties of everyday materials. We will compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties. We will work scientifically by performing simple tests to explore questions.

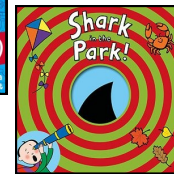
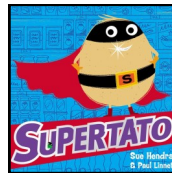
Computing:
