What did Jesus do to save human beings?

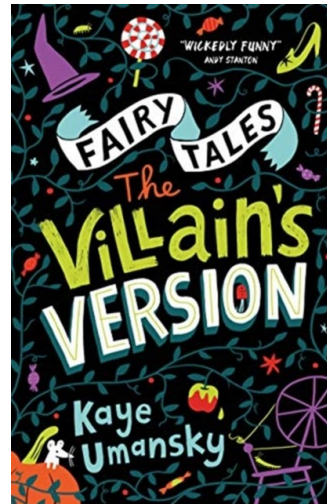
PE:
