English:

In English we will be reading and exploring the work of Julia Donaldson. We will express likes and dislikes through book reviews and complete comprehension tasks to develop our understanding of inference from a text. We will be writing in different formats such as letters, songs and posters. We will have a focus on rhyming words and explore what it means when a word rhymes with another, coming up with our own rhymes too.

Mathematics:

In mathematics, we will be building on our knowledge of number and place value by looking at and working with numbers to 40. We will continue to partition numbers and explore methods of addition and subtraction following the Maths No Problem scheme. We develop our knowledge of geometry and learn to identify and describe 2D and 3D shapes.

Science: Plants and Trees

In our science lessons we will be recapping the different parts and functions of a flower, making models and labelling them. We will learn to identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees by identifying trees by their leaves. We will sort and classify plants and trees by our own decided criteria.

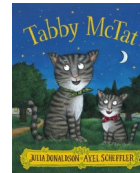
Geography

Religious Education - Creation
