Literacy:

As readers we will be finding out about WW2 through a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. Our main work will be centred around the book 'Friend or Foe' by Michael Morpurgo.

As writers we will be writing persuasive letters, newspaper entries and fictitious writing.

Maths:

Maths No Problem

Subtraction

We will continue our work on subtraction.

Multiplication and Division

We will learn how to multiply and divide by 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12. They will learn how to calculate multiplication equations using the multiplication facts that they know.

Science: Sound We will be learning about how to:

- identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating
- recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear
- find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it
- find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it

Computing:

The children will be taught to use search engines safely and effectively to find information for our topic.
The children will continue to learn how to write and debug programmes for the Ozobots.

The children will learn how to use research skills to find out information about the effect WW2 had on children in Britain.
