English:

We will be using Podkin One Ear by Kieran Larwood to inspire our writing. We will explore and create descriptive settings and characters, including creating our own fictional maps to set our own stories in. We will also come up with alternative endings to the story.

Reading:

In 'Whitley Reading' sessions we will be developing our inference skills, using texts including 'Podkin One Ear' and 'The Streets Beneath My Feet'.

Maths:

In addition and subtraction, we will be adding and subtracting 1s, 10s and 100s and adding and subtracting 2 and 3 digit numbers with and without exchanging. We will also be multiplying and dividing across the x-tables.

Science:

As geologists we will continue our study of rocks, fossils and soils. We will learn how soils are made from rock and organic matter. We will compare and separate soils.

RE:

In RE we will be exploring the question: 'What are the deeper meanings of festivals?" We will identify the main beliefs in religious festivals and make links between the beliefs and the stories recalled at these festivals. We will describe how believers celebrate festivals in different ways.


PE:
