Platinum Jubilee Beacon Event- The event will begin in the Market Square at 8pm on Thursday 2nd June 2022. There is a poster on our Facebook page.



Program of Events

- 2.05pm- Gates open for parents to arrive
- 2.20pm- All parents arrived and gates locked (safeguarding.)
 - 2.25pm- Crown parades by children
 - 2.35pm- Food to be eaten
 - 2.50pm- All children to return to their class group.
 - 2.55pm- Children to sing Jubilee Song.
 - 3.05pm- All children back into class rooms.
 - 3.10pm- Home time.

Arrangements:

- > Maximum of two adults per child, preferably one.
- > Parents can only take their own child to sit with them, unless they are sitting in the class group.
- > Parents can take older siblings to sit with younger siblings, but must inform the class teacher so that the teacher can make a record of this. These children must be returned to their class group at 2.50pm.
- > All other children will sit in a class group with the class teacher.
- > Morning Nursery children can attend but must be accompanied by an adult.
- > Children to be provided with food by school.
- > Parents to bring own food and rugs. Please do not give food to children, other than your own child, due to allergies.
- > Dress code- Non-uniform/ Garden Party
- > Children to bring water bottles and to wear sun-cream and sun hats.

Year Group Zones:

- > Years 5 and 6 will be sitting on the UKS2 grass, opposite the Year 6 classrooms.
- > Years 1, 2,3 and 4 will be sitting on the main field.
- Nursery and Reception will be sitting on the field where the adventure trail is.

Unfortunately, if it is raining, the event will be cancelled for parents and the children will have their food in the classrooms.
