This half term, we will be working on our written forms of multiplication and division that predominantly use partitioning. We will also learn how to measure in mm, cm and metres and begin looking at fractions.

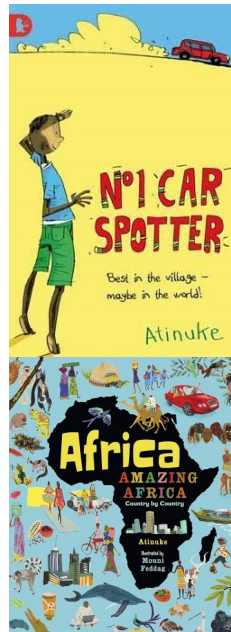
