


Our starting story this half term in Nursery is **Dinosaur Roar!!**

<p>COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to stories • Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories and rhymes • Listen to each other in small group • Begin to take turns in conversations • Boogie mites 	<p>PERSONAL SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn the routines in the Unit • Make new friends • Put on their coat and hang it up • Take turns and share when playing • Try new things • Be kind and helpful • Introduce Tommy the Try Hard Tortoise 	<p>PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose their own snack • Wash hands before their have snack and after they have been to the toilet • Balance on 1 leg • Move in different ways • Squiggle when you wiggle- draw top to bottom lines
<p>LITERACY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify different environmental sounds • Make sounds with their bodies • Handle books carefully • Begin to talk about things they draw and write • Talk about the pictures in books • Core Books- Dinosaur Roar! Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What can you see? It was a cold dark night • Introduce Helicopter stories 	 <p>Dinosaur Roar!</p> <p>Other themes will be developed as we follow the children's interests</p>	<p>MATHEMATICS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subtise numbers 1,2 (look at a set and know how many they can see without counting) • Sort and match objects into sets • Explore patterns <p><u>Maths Vocabulary</u> match, sort, notice, groups, sets, same, different, nearly the same, colour</p>
<p>UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Begin to talk about their families • Talk about different times in the day • Explore the school environment and local area • Explore forces they can feel • Introduce e-safety when using computers 	<p>EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore and name different colours • Draw a face with all the features it needs • Snip with scissors • Use a variety of construction toys and talk about their models • Sing traditional songs and rhymes 	<p>RE</p> <p>Celebrate Harvest Festival</p> <p>Core Value Generosity 'It is good to give.' (This is an area which the whole school develops. There is a new core value each half term)</p>
