In maths we will be using NCETM materials to learn about calculating with decimal fractions, factors, multiples and primes.

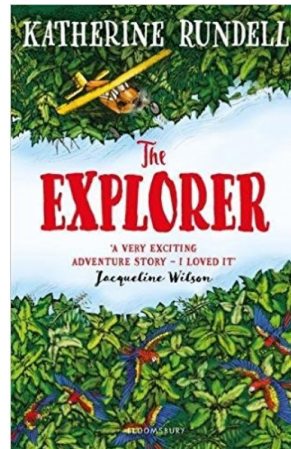
Science: Properties/changing of materials.
