Maths:

This half-term will continue to use the NCETM curriculum prioritisation framework. We will reap and practice the column subtraction method as well as looking at securing mental strategies. We will begin to look at unit fractions. We will understand that a fraction of something is part of the whole.

Science - Plants

We will recap the parts of a plant and consolidate understanding of each part's function. We will investigate questions such as 'What are the best conditions for germination?' and 'What is pollination?'

RE- Why do Christians call the day Jesus died "Good Friday"?

We will learn the events of the Christian Holy week. We will describe how Christians show their beliefs about Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday in worship. We will •Offer suggestions for what the texts about the entry into Jerusalem and the death and resurrection of Jesus might mean.

In our art lessons, we will be learning to draw using simple shapes through still life drawing. We will be practicing our shading technique as well as creating texture on our drawings using rubbings.
