Science— Materials (Working Scientifically)

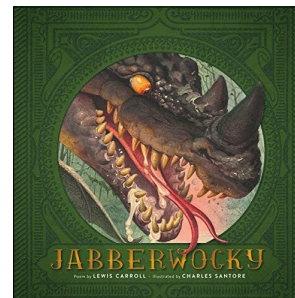
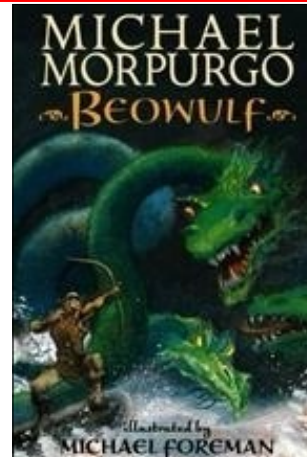
We will investigate everyday materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity or response to magnets.
