Maths:

This term we will explore negative numbers before learning about short division and multiplication methods.

French: *Mon école et moi*—we will learn French vocabulary to discuss our school day and routines.

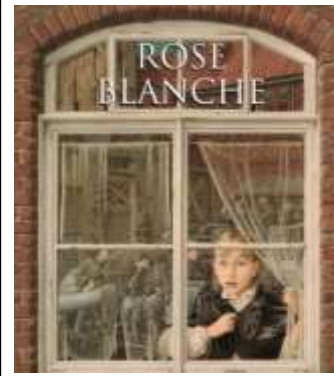
Science: Forces—How strong is gravity? We will explore the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction on gravity. We will investigate mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears.

Computing: Video Editing

We will be learning how to capture video using digital devices and considering the impact of the choices made when making and sharing a video.

WHY?

We will be exploring this term's core value of compassion and kindness through a picture book with a powerful message—Rose Blanche.

We will be learning about how to show compassion and what it means to be compassionate.

History:

Why was winning the battle of Britain in 1940 so important? We will be investigating the Battle of Britain as a significant turning point in British History.

Art: Painting and mixed media: portraits.

We will be investigating self-portraits by a range of artists and using photographs of ourselves to create our own self-portraits in mixed-media.

DT: Textiles: Stuffed toys.

Design a stuffed toy and make decisions on materials, decorations and attachments (appendages), after learning how to sew a blanket stitch.

PSHE: Recognising and celebrating difference.

Including, religious and cultural difference and the influence and pressures of social media.

RE: Was Jesus the Messiah? An exploration into why *Jesus* is believed by Christians to be the *Messiah* promised in the Old Testament.

Music: We will be learning about Jazz and improvisation, as well as preparing for our Christmas performances.

PE: The Real PE focus for this term is communication and teamwork. We will also learn dance/gymnastic skills.
