English/Communication:

As writers we will use The Write Stuff approach to develop effective sentences for our comedy story and non-chronological report. We will hold experience days, to work collaboratively to gather vocabulary and ideas for use in our writing. We will be developing our understanding of nouns, adjectives, verbs, noun phrases, time adverbials, onomatopoeia, similes, alliteration and synonyms. We will be writing using full stops, capital letters, question marks, commas and exclamation marks. We will begin to use inverted commas to demarcate speech. We will use a narrative map and the "Writing Rainbow" to create our own independent writing.

Maths:

This half-term will continue to use the NCETM curriculum prioritisation framework. We will recap numbers to 1000 and begin to learn column addition and subtraction as well as problems involving the 2, 4 and 8 times tables. In our maths meetings we will be securing mental strategies.

Science: Animals including humans

We will be investigating different food groups and types of nutrition. We will be finding out about different types of skeletons and naming bones. We will learn about the main functions of the skeleton and how muscles work. We will be working scientifically to set up a simple experiment, make modifications, record results and write an explanation of our findings.


RE:
