


Our starting theme this half term is '**Superheroes**'

<p>COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to stories • Anticipate phrases in rhymes and stories • Listen to each other and answer questions in small group activities and in Talk partner time • Talk about what is happening next in stories • Build up a vocabulary linked to the Superheroes 	<p>PERSONAL SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play in groups • Begin to initiate play activities for their friends • Begins to accept needs of others and take turns and share resources • People who help me and keep me safe • Safety Indoors and outdoors • What's safe to go into my body • Introduce shine certificates 	<p>PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use 1 handed tools safely • Begin to establish a good pencil hold • Introduce yoga exercises • Take off and put on their shoes and socks all by themselves • Dance and Draw exercises
<p>LITERACY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Begin to talk about things they draw and write • Recognise their own name and familiar words in the environment • Identify the initial sounds in words • Hear the differences in sounds at the beginning of words • Begin copy the first letter in their own name • Develop an awareness of the structures of stories • Core book- Oi Frog, Dear Zoo, Supertato 	<p>Our Starting story is...</p>  <p>Other themes may be developed as we follow the children's interests</p>	<p>MATHEMATICS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recite numbers in sequence • Recognise some numerals to 5 • Subtising 1,2,3 • Shapes <div data-bbox="1098 1153 1492 1393" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"> <p>Maths Vocabulary Numbers, numerals, subtising Triangle, squares, rectangles, circles</p> </div>
<p>UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore forces • People who help me and keep me safe e.g. nurses. doctors, police and fire fighters • Name our country and other countries by looking at maps and atlases • Read stories from other cultures 	<p>EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing Superheroes songs • Move in response to different music • Pretend to be a different superhero • Draw people with heads, legs and arms • Use simple hinges • Make collages using different textures 	<p>RE/CORE VALUE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Courage 'Sometimes we need to be brave' • Talk about belonging to different groups, families or clubs

You can help at home by

- Counting actions and objects in the home environment
- Drawing people with heads, legs and arms
- Sharing stories, which having rhyming words in them
- Begin to write the first sound own name
- Looking for objects that start with the same sound as their name
