Hello everybody! First of all let me take this opportunity to thank you all for your support through this difficult time. ## PRIMARY PLANS

At last we have the news from the government that we all wanted to hear - the children will be back in school at the start of September! We still don't know exactly what this will look like but we will keep you informed.

Primary plans are well under way. **Building work** is starting as soon as school finishes - we will have a new kitchen and the Key Stage 1 classrooms are all being enlarged with a complete refit of the outside creative area and toilets. Everyone is very excited about this and can't wait to see what it looks like.

As you can see at the top we have changed the wording on our **badge**, but do not intend to alter the logo as we feel that this strongly represents our past and connections with St Cuthbert's Church.
