Following White Rose maths, we will continue to learn about multiplication, division and fractions before moving on to decimals and percentages.




We will explore why the Torah is so important to Jewish people and how it is used as a source of guidance for their lives.

We will continue to investigate the effects of air resistance, water resistance, friction and gravity.




