English:

In English, we will be continuing our work on different sentence types, understanding how to use these sentences then applying them to our own writing effectively.

We will also be developing character description skills, our understanding of verbs as well as past and present tense. We will continue to our work on sentence structure as well as exploring the impact different conjunctions and punctuation can have on a sentence.

We will continue our work on Year 2 Spelling rules as well as the Common Exception Words.

Maths: Measurement, Money and Multiplication and Division.

As mathematicians we will be recognising and identifying a variety of coins and exploring the concept of their worth. We will continue to use and build upon our knowledge of place value by adding and subtracting coins.

In multiplication, we will start to make the connection between repeated addition and multiplication as well as identifying equal and unequal groups as well as counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will continue to use TTRock Stars throughout this term to help improve our fluency so please practice at home.

Science: Living things and their habitats

As scientists we will be introduced to the seven life processes and explore how these can be used to tell the difference between things that are living, dead and those that have never been alive. We will develop our scientific skills for sorting and classifying, interpreting and creating Venn Diagrams.

Geography: Why does it matter where my food comes from?

We will recognise that all the food we eat comes from either plants or animals and that a farm is an area of land. We will find out about dairy farms and identify key geographical features of the Devon countryside and compare it with towns and cities.

Art and design: Painting and mixed media

As artists we be continuing to develop our knowledge of painting and mixed media. We will look at the artist Romare Bearden and explore ways in which we can use collage and mixed media to create our own piece of art work.

PE: Games attacking and defending.

In P.E this term we will be working on our attacking and defending strategies within a variety of games. We will also be learning how to work tactically and communicate effectively as part of a team.

PSHE Keeping Myself Safe

We will be learning about medicines and how they can be helpful or harmful, and say some examples of how they can be used safely. We will learn how to identify situations in we would need to say 'Yes', 'No', 'I'll ask', or 'I'll tell'.

RE: Creation: Who do Christians say made the world?

The children will discuss who created the world and the story of Creation. They will explore why God made a day of rest and why god wants us to protect and care for his world. Music: Musical Me.

As musician we will be learning to follow a rhythm and to sing a melody accurately while playing their instrument in time. We will explore what timbres means and how instruments can reflect different emotions. We will represent this using both instruments and our voices.
