Topic

Our starting interests this half term is **Sowing a seed** This half term in Nursery we will be learning to . . .

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

- Use talk to connect ideas and explain what is happening
- Listen to their friends ideas in small group activities
- Talk about what might happen next in stories

Vocabulary: ideas, talk, listen, look, explain, now, then, next

PERSONAL SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Talk about looking after themselves, each other and the environment
- Introduce Charlie the Chimp
- Put on their coat and shoes independently

Vocabulary: talk, words, voice, independent, friendly, kind, share

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Dance in different ways to stay healthy
- Use small tools e.g. scissors and pencils
- Explore tying objects together

Vocabulary: cut, straight, dance, sway, tie, follow, instruction

LITERACY

- Begin to talk about things they draw and write
- Explore alliteration and find words which start with the same initial sound as their name
- Create their own helicopter stories
- Core book-Monkey Puzzle, Three little pigs, WOW said the owl
- Talk about story characters

Vocabulary: tell me, repeat, letter, alliteration, shapes, words, copy, write, character

- Recite numbers in order
- Subtising to 4
- Introduce 5 and 10 frames
- Explore height, length, mass and capacity

Vocabulary:

5 and 10 frames

Height- tall, short, same Mass-weight, heavy, light, heavier,

lighter, balance

Length-long, short, longer, shorter Capacity-full, empty, half full, liquid

- Plant seeds and care for plants
- Explore light
- Draw simple maps
- Talk about the differences between themselves and the characters in the Peepo story
- Celebrate the Holi Festival

Vocabulary: seed, fruit, plant, grow, decay, life cycle, light source, shiny, bright, reflective, non-reflective History, event, old, new Maps, land, sea, river journey,

adventure Celebrate, Festival, same, different
