English:

Children are reading the book 'The Rain Player' and exploring a Mayan game called Pok-A-Tok. They will go on to use this information they have learned to create advertisements, dialogue in a missing scene, newspaper reports, conduct debates and write analytical essays.

Maths: Shape

We will firstly continue our work on area and perimeter, exploring how to find the circumference of a circle and looking at how to find the volume of cubes and cuboids. Afterwards, we will move onto shape where we explore angles of different regular shapes in depth and we recap and build on our 2D and 3D shape knowledge from previous years.

Science: Living things and their habitat

This half term we will explore the history of classification (including the work of Linnaeus), grouping micro-organisms, grouping plants, grouping animals and using and devising classification keys.

Computing: Manipulating images

Children will be using specific programmes to understand skills to manipulate various images. We will discuss the importance of using AI appropriately and safely.

Geography: Around the world

Children will reflect on geography as a subject. They will be discussing how geography helps us to understand the world and how it works whilst exploring jobs linked to geography.
