English:

In English, we will continue to develop our reading fluency and comprehension skills. Our core text, *The Wilderness*, will inspire a range of writing including setting descriptions, poetry, character advice, and an imaginative guide for surviving in the wild. We will explore how authors use language for effect and begin to edit and publish our work for display. In SPAG, we will focus on using noun phrases, adverbial phrases, conjunctions, and the four sentence types to add detail and variety to our writing.

Maths:

In maths we will be learning to identify, drawing and comparing angles. We will be able to identify parallel, perpendicular, horizontal and vertical lines in shapes. We will consolidate learning on recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes. We will be working in the areas of money, time and measurement.

Science: Magnets and Forces

As scientists, we will compare how things move on different surfaces. We will explore magnetic force. We will investigate how magnets attract and repel each other and attract some materials and not others. We will identify magnetic materials. We will be learning that magnets have two poles.

RE:

In RE, we explored the question, *How and why do peo*ple try to make the world a better place? We learned about different religious and non-religious views and thought about the small actions we can take to help others and care for the world.
