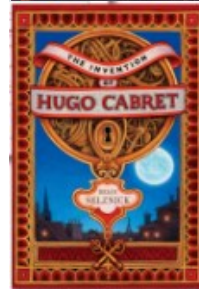

English: The arrival: Children will explore characters, emotions, different points of view and the challenges faced by the main character and some of the other characters that have made their way to the new land.
The invention of Hugo Caberet: Children will use many of the key grammar requirements of Y6 and have opportunity to apply them by writing a missing flashback chapter exploring Hugo's experience of living Uncle Claude, as well as researching the about the famous film director George Méliès and writing a biography about his life.

Maths: Number and place value.
Children will read, write, order and compare numbers to 10,000,000. They will explore powers of 10. Children will round integers and deepen their understanding of negative numbers

Science: Animals including humans.

What does our blood do? Children will identify and name the circulatory system and describe the functions of the heart. We will describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals including humans.

Computing:

During this unit, children will use search technologies effectively, safely and responsibly. They will identify a range of ways to report concerns.

History: Ancient Greece

What is the legacy of the ancient Greek civilisation ?

DT: Structures: Playgrounds

Children will research existing playground equipment and their different forms, before designing and developing a range of apparatus to meet a list of specified design criteria.

French:

Children will name the subjects they study in school, in French, with the correct definite article/determiner. They will extend sentences by giving an opinion on the various school subjects and extend even further by giving a justification for that subject.

PSHE:

Using SCARF framework we will be looking at: Feelings, friendship skills including compromise and assertive skills.

RE:

What does it mean for Muslims to follow God?

Music:

We will use Charanga to support our music learning.
