Time Allocation: 1/2 term

Date: Autumn Term 1—2025

Classes: Morpeth

English: We will be using 'Robot Girl' by Malorie Blackman to inspire our writing. We will use a range of techniques to create characters and settings. Finally, we will write our own science fiction narrative linked to this book.

Reading: For our comprehension focus we will explore a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts.

Maths:

This term we will be learning all about place-value, including comparing and ordering numbers and rounding before moving on to addition and subtraction. We also learn about multiplication and division whilst continuing to embed our multiplication facts.

Science:

Sun, Earth & Moon: What is moving and how do we know?

We will investigate the movement of the Earth and other planets around the sun. As well as exploring the phases of the moon and finding out why we have day and night.


RE: How can following God bring freedom and justice?

We will be learning about:

The different ways you can be resilient.

Geography: Why are mountains so important? Year 5 will focus on naming and locating mountains and ranges, investigate how mountains are formed, use maps and compare mountains in the UK to Everest.
