Enalish:

Our core text this half term is Mr Penguin and the Lost Treasure by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre. We will explore the features of adventure stories and write our own tales inspired by Mr Penguin's daring guests. We will also continue to build reading fluency and comprehension skills. In SPaG, we will focus on using adverbs, prepositions and expanded noun phrases to add detail and description to our writing.



Let Your Light Shine Matthew 5:16

History - Would you prefer to have lived in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age? Children will explore how life changed across these periods, comparing homes, tools and ways of living before deciding which age they would have preferred to live in and explaining why.

Maths:

In addition and subtraction, we will be adding and subtracting 1s, 10s and 100s and adding and subtracting 2 and 3 digit numbers with and without exchanging. We will also be multiplying and dividing across the multiplication tables.

Science:

As geologists we will continue our study of rocks, fossils and soils. We will learn how soils are made from rock and organic matter. We will compare and separate soils.

Respect

Core Value:

We will learn the value and importance of respect through stories, discussions and our reflections.

RE:

In RE we will be exploring the question: 'What kind of world did Jesus want? Through studying the stories in the Bible, we will make links between the first disciples and Christians today. We will unpick the actions of Jesus to determine what kind of world he wanted for us.
