English: Billy and The Beast.

In English we will be exploring the text "Billy and the Beast" by Nadian Shireen. We will use this text to create character and setting descriptions using adjectives. We will complete a narrative retelling of the story and then move on to writing an alternative ending.

Maths: Addition and Subtraction.

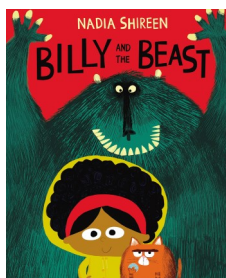
As mathematicians we will be building on our knowledge of place value and be completing addition and subtraction calculations. We will complete single digit addition and subtraction, focus on number bonds to 10 and use our skills to solve one step addition and subtraction word problems.

Science: Why do we have different seasons?

As Scientists, we will be exploring the four seasons. We will discuss the changes which happen during these seasons and what evidence we can find in our local environment. We will focus on how we know Autumn has arrived and monitor the changes within the physical environment and the weather.

R.E: Why is Christmas important to Christians?

In our RE we will be learning about the importance of Christmas to Christians, discuss the meaning of advent and how it is celebrated by Christians. We will learn about the story of the birth of Baby Jesus and why Jesus is so important for Christians. We will also find out about the festival of Diwali.

We will learn the value and importance of respect through stories, discussions

Design Technology: Puppets.

As designers, we will learn how to join fabric together using a variety of techniques. We will design and make a puppet by using a template. We will then join the fabric together to create our own hand puppets to match our designs.

Computing: Exploring digital Sound

During ICT, we will introduce children to digital sound, and let them experiment with simple beats, tempo and composition with various tools.
