


**Year 4 - Spring 1 2026**

**English** - In English, we will begin by exploring the story 'Granny Came Here on the Empire Windrush' by Patrice Lawrence, using it as inspiration to write our own diary recounts. Later in the term, we will study 'The Selfish Giant' by Oscar Wilde and use the themes from the story to help us write a persuasive letter.



**Humanities**- As historians we will be learning about what changed in Britain after the Anglo-Saxon invasion.

**Art / DT** - We will be learning about fabric, textiles and fastenings.

**Maths** - As mathematicians, we will continue to learn all about multiplication and division. We will develop our understanding of factors and multiplying by 10 and 100. We will go on to learn formal methods for multiplying and dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers by one digit. We will also learn about length and perimeter.



**ICT - Programming Scratch Maze Games.** We will learn to program sprites with arrow keys to navigate drawn mazes, detect colours for win/lose conditions, and build skills in events, coordinates, and logic.

**Music - Stop!** We will be composing a song/rap written in a Grime style.

**Science - Sound** In Science, we will explore sound. We will focus on understanding sound as vibrations that travel through a medium to the ear, learning patterns in pitch and volume and recognising that sounds fade with distance from the source.
