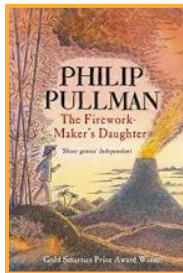


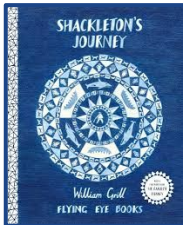
Year 4 - Autumn 2 2025



English - In English, we will be exploring the text 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman. We will be developing our skills as authors by writing a 'lost chapter' inspired by the story. We will craft character and setting descriptions and learn how to add dialogue to our stories. We will go on to write balanced arguments, considering human impacts on extreme environments, inspired by the book Shackleton's Journey by William Grill.



Maths - As mathematicians, we will learn all about multiplication and division. We will explore the links between the times tables. We will develop our understanding that multiplication is commutative and explore fact families to embed our understanding of division as the inverse of multiplication.



Science - In Science, we will continue our exploration of the States of Matter. We will investigate the water cycle and learn about the scientists - Celsius and Fahrenheit.

RE - In RE, we will continue to learn about Sikhism, delving into the importance of the 5Ks and the Khalsa to Sikhs. We will explore how Sikhs celebrate big moments in life and how Sikhs put faith into action in Britain and the world.
