



**Year 4 - Spring 2 2026**

**English** - We will explore 'FArTHER' by Grahame Baker-Smith to develop narrative writing, focusing on descriptive language. We will practise selecting ambitious vocabulary and crafting sentences to create detailed imagery and atmosphere. We will also write an explanation text linked to 'Until I Met Dudley' by Roger McGough, learning how to organise ideas into clear sections, use subject-specific vocabulary and explain processes in a logical sequence.

**Maths** - As mathematicians we will explore fractions and decimals, focusing on developing a solid understanding of equivalent fractions, introducing hundredths and connecting them to decimal places (tenths and hundredths).

**Science - Electricity** As scientists, we will learn to identify household appliances powered by electricity, distinguish between mains and battery power, and construct simple series circuits using cells, wires, bulbs, switches, and buzzers.

**RE - Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?** We will explore the narrative of Holy Week, understanding the transition from the hope of Palm Sunday to the sadness of Good Friday and the joy of Easter Sunday.

**Humanities- Water** As Geographers, we will be learning why water is essential for human life and identifying some of the causes and consequences of people not being able to access water.

**ICT -3D Design.** We will introduce 3D modelling and design and take a look at how these skills are used in the real world in a huge variety of different careers.

**Music - Lean on Me.** We will be learning all about soul and gospel music.

**PSHE -Rights and Respect.** We will learn to identify some rights and also responsibilities that come with these.

**French - Je me presente.** We will learn how to introduce ourselves in French.
