


Year 1 - Spring 1 2026




Teachers: Miss Highgate and Miss Smith

English: As writers, we will begin by exploring the story 'Dadaji's Paintbrush' by Rashmi Sirdeshpande, using it as inspiration to write our own diary recounts. Later in the term, we will study 'Iggy Peck, Architect' by Andrea Beaty and use the themes from the story to help us write a persuasive letter.



Humanities: Geography: The UK: As geographers, we will be locating the UK on a world map and naming its 4 countries and capital cities.

Maths: As mathematicians, we will be developing our understanding of numbers up to 20. We will be practising counting forwards and backwards to 20 as well as focusing on the place value of each number. We will then move on to adding and subtracting within 20 through a variety of methods.



Art: As artists we will be exploring line and shape when drawing. We will be experimenting with different materials.

ICT: Making multimedia stories
We will be writing and creating digital stories, bringing them to life with sound and animation

Science: As scientists, we will be investigating a variety of plants. We will be learning the names of some common wild and garden plants and looking at their basic structure. We will be learning what a plant needs to grow healthily.

Music: In the Groove: As musicians, we will be learning about a variety of music styles, including Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk.

RE: Who is Muslim and how do they live?
We will be learning about the Muslim faith, Islam, making comparisons to our own lives and beliefs. We will be studying a variety of special Islamic objects.
