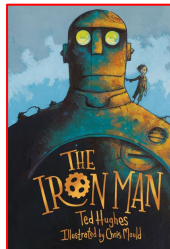


Year 4 - Summer 1 2026



English - This term, we will be exploring narrative writing through fresh perspectives, focusing on how key events can be retold from a character's point of view. Using *The Iron Man* as our core text, we will develop our understanding of storytelling by considering thoughts, feelings and motivations to deepen our writing. We will organise our ideas into clear paragraphs and use a range of sentence structures, including fronted adverbials, prepositional phrases and subordinate clauses, to improve flow and cohesion.



Maths - As mathematicians, we will continue to explore decimals, before moving on to money and time. We will learn to convert between pounds and pence and how to read the 24 hour clock.

Science - Animals including humans. As scientists, we will focus on how bodies process food, the different types of teeth we use to eat and how energy moves through nature.

RE - What is it like to follow God? We will focus on stories from the Old Testament, looking at characters from Noah to the prophets. We will explore how Christians today shape their lives to follow God and be People of God.
