

**Year 1 - Summer 2 2026**

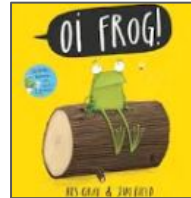
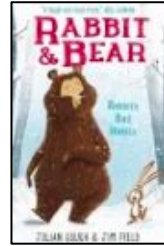
**English:** We will use the story of "Rabbit and Bear: Rabbit's bad habits to inspire our writing. We will work towards creating our own leaflet to encourage people to visit the forest. We will focus on the organisational features of a leaflet such as, headings, labels and captions. Later in the term, we will dive into the imaginative world of poetry using the story of 'Oi Frog!' to inspire us.

**Maths:** As mathematicians, we will explore numbers to 100, including counting, partitioning into tens and ones and using a number line. We will also practise finding 1 more and 1 less and comparing numbers up to 100. We will also begin to learn about money by recognising coins and notes before moving on to telling the time to the hour and half hour.

**Science: Animals, including humans**

As Scientists we will learn how to sort and group animals based on their characteristics. We will explore what makes an animal a mammal, as well as identify and compare the key features of birds, reptiles, and amphibians.

**RE: Who am I? What does it mean to belong to a faith community?** In RE, we will learn about belonging and the different communities people are part of. We will explore how faiths celebrate belonging and why communities help people feel loved, safe, and supported.
