**English:**

In English, we will continue to develop our reading fluency and comprehension skills. Using Egyptian Cinderella as our inspiration, we will write an engaging travel guide to Egypt, exploring how writers organise information using headings, paragraphs, and factual language. Later in the half term, we will study A Necklace of Raindrops and use rich vocabulary and imagery to create our own poetry. In SPAG, we will focus on using fronted adverbials, conjunctions, prepositions, and expanded noun phrases to add detail, cohesion, and interest to our writing.

**Maths:**

In maths we will be learning to identify, drawing and comparing angles. We will be able to identify parallel, perpendicular, horizontal and vertical lines in shapes. We will consolidate learning on recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes. We will be working in the areas of money, time and measurement.

**Science: Magnets and Forces**

As scientists, we will compare how things move on different surfaces. We will explore magnetic force. We will investigate how magnets attract and repel each other and attract some materials and not others. We will identify magnetic materials. We will be learning that magnets have two poles.

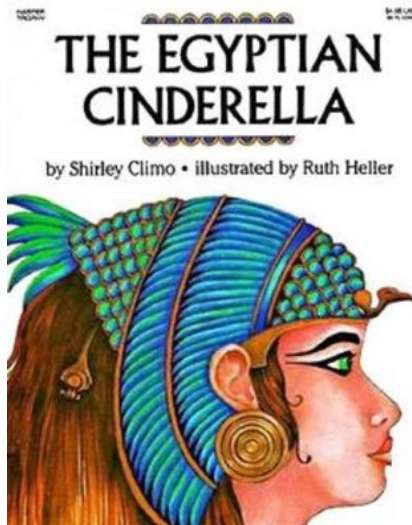
**RE**

**History:**

In History, we will travel back in time to Ancient Egypt.
