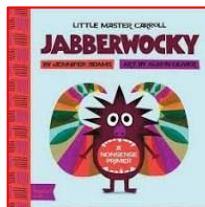


Year 4 - Summer 2 2026



English - This term, we will develop our non-fiction writing and poetry skills through two exciting units. First, we will create an engaging travel guide to London, inspired by the adventures in *Two Weeks with the Queen* by Morris Gleitzman. We will learn how to organise information into clear paragraphs, use headings and subheadings, and choose from a range of sentence types to inform and persuade our readers. We will explore London's famous landmarks, transport, and attractions, building rich vocabulary to help us write like real travel writers. Later in the term, we will dive into the imaginative world of poetry through Lewis Carroll's *Jabberwocky*.



Maths - As mathematicians, we will investigate shape, including identifying angles. We will learn about statistics through interpreting graphs and charts. We will also learn to describe position using coordinates.

Science - Living things and their habitats. As scientists, we will learn how to classify plants and animals using branching yes-or-no keys, while exploring how natural and human-induced environmental changes impact local habitats.

RE - What are the deeper meanings of festivals? We will investigate how different faiths and cultures celebrate important beliefs and stories through festivals.

Humanities- Investigating major world cities: London. As geographers we will develop an understanding of London as the capital city of England and the UK. We will learn how it functions, the role it plays and its significance to tourism and transport.

ICT - Computational Thinking - Alien Contact! We will design and debug an algorithm to decode alien signals.
