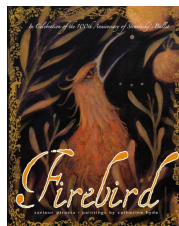


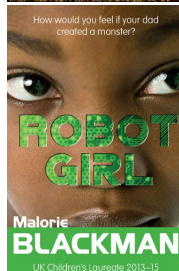
Year 5 - Autumn 1 2026



English - In English, we will use the book 'Firebird' by Saviour Pirotta to inspire us to create our own descriptive narratives. We will be focusing on developing a setting description that creates a clear mood and atmosphere. We will also be using the book 'Robot Girl' by Malorie Blackman to create biographies.



Maths - As mathematicians, we will focus on place value; working with numbers up to 1,000,000. This will include reading and writing these larger numbers, partitioning them and comparing and ordering them. We will also be working on our addition and subtraction - learning how to add and subtract numbers with more than four digits.



Science - In science, our unit will be based on Earth and Space. This includes organising all the planets in the solar system into groups, looking at why we have day and night and observing and identifying all the phases in the cycle of the moon.

RE - Our unit is named 'For Christians, how can following God bring freedom and justice?'. We will look at what it means to be 'people of God' and look at the importance of the Ten Commandments in ideas of freedom and justice.

Music - In music we will be focusing on music in nature: Chords and melodies.
